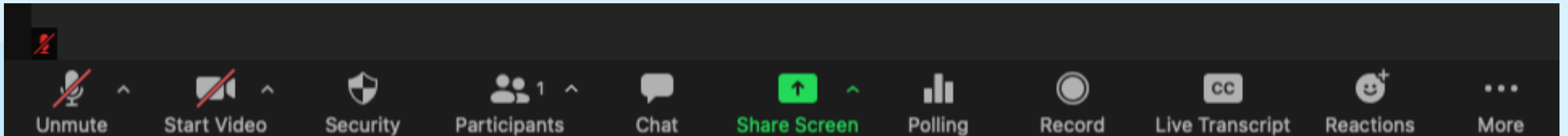


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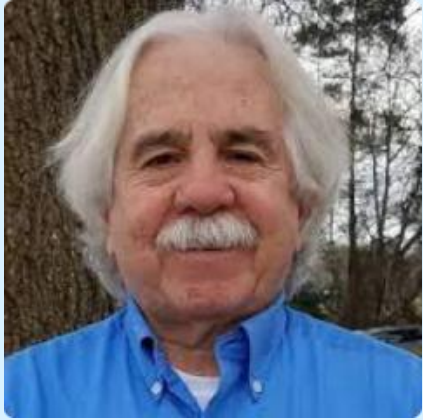

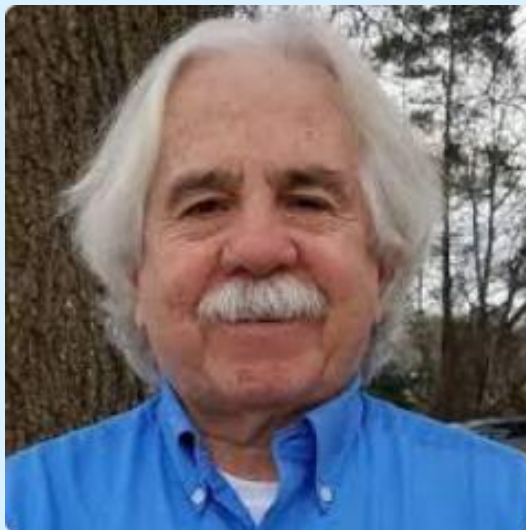

Things to Think About

Looking for work is hard work!

In the old days, help wanted **ads** were in the **newspaper**. You would **call** or **send** a **letter** to **apply** for a **job**. You would go in person to fill out a paper application!

There are some **places** where you **apply in person** when there is a **sign in the window**.

But employers might want you to fill out an **application online** at their company or do it on their **website**. Being prepared to do both is a good way to make sure you can **do your best!**



Take Action: Job Sites

More Things You Can Do To Check Out Job Sites:

1. Ask your **tech partner or job coach** to help you **apply** for jobs you are **interested in**.
2. Keep a **list** of the places where you **apply**.
3. You can also upload your **resume** for employers to find.
4. Tell your **references** where you have **applied**.

3. Tell your **references** where you have **applied**.

1. Go to a **job app site** to see if there are jobs listed you might be interested in.
2. **Save** the ones you might want to apply for using a **BOOKMARK**.
3. Get your tech partner or job coach to **help** you **apply**.
